

Canadian Junior Table Tennis Championships

Edmonton, Alberta

March 28-31, 2001

1. General Information

The Championships will be held from March 28 –31, 2001 at the MacEwan Centre for Sport and Wellness in Edmonton, Alberta

The entry will be accepted only if it includes:

- Participant's name, address and birthdate
- Fees paid in full
- Clear indication of events entered
- Signature of participant's parents/guardian

The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the I.T.T.F. and C.T.T.A.

Note to players: Matching uniforms must be worn for team matches and all doubles events.

2. Eligibility

To be eligible to enter the Canadian Junior Championships, a player must be either a Canadian Citizen, or a Landed Immigrant for at least one (1) YEAR PRIOR TO THE FIRST DAY OF THE Championships; with at least six (6) months residence in the province for the period immediately preceding the first day of the Championships; and not having represented another country in any international event in the three (3) years prior to the first day of the Championships. Players may enter an age category of their choice, for which they are eligible and the one immediately above in singles and doubles events.

3. Event Restrictions

U19: Players must be born on or after July 1,1981

U17 : Players must be born on or after July 1,1983

U14: Players must be born on or after July 1, 1986

U12: Players must be born on or after July 1, 1988

U10: Players must be born on or after July 1, 1990

Players may enter a maximum of six (6) events: 2 singles, 2 doubles, 2 mixed doubles (see Eligibility above).

Umpires and officials who are financially supported by Federal or Provincial grant as selected Tournament Officials cannot participate in any event.

NOTE: The organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel any event due to insufficient entries (minimum 8 in singles, 4 in doubles).

4. Entry Fees

Age Groups: U10, U12, U14, & U17	\$120.00
U19 only:	\$50.00
Team Entry: per province	\$200.00
Rating fee:	\$3.00
Umpire fee:	\$5.00

5. Format

All matches will be decided on the best two out of three games.

6. Draw

The draw will be held at the CTTA Office in Ottawa on March 12, 2001

The latest rating period available at the time of the draw shall be used to determine the seeding order for all events.

Seeding of players shall be based on their rating points.

Seeding of Doubles shall be based upon the combined rating points of both players.

Unrated players may be given an estimated rating by the National Rating Director.

7. Equipment

8. Meetings

The Jury Meeting will be held on Tuesday, March 27, 2001 at 7:00 p.m. in the Wood Buffalo Room at the Edmonton Coast Plaza Hotel (10155 – 105 Street) and will be chaired by the Referee. Each Provincial Association with participating athletes is entitled to one (1) vote.

The officials Meeting will be held after the Jury meeting on Tuesday, March 27, 2001 at 9:00 p.m. in the Wood Buffalo Room at the Edmonton Coast Plaza Hotel (10155 – 105 Street) and will be chaired by the Referee and Umpire Manager.

9. Awards

In all individual events (singles and doubles), awards will be presented to the winner, runner-up as well as both 3rd place finishers, and in addition certificates will be presented will be presented to all U-10 players.

The Province accumulating the most overall points (U-10) included will be awarded the Jacques Bobet Trophy.

The Junior Male Athlete of the year will be awarded the Jean Duquette Trophy.

The Junior Female Athlete of the year will be awarded the Denise Hunnius Trophy.

The Swaythling Cup International Silver Bat will be awarded to player for "Fair Play" during the tournament.

The banquet and awards ceremony will take place Saturday evening, March 31th in the Valley Ballroom at the Edmonton Coast Plaza Hotel, 10155 – 105 Street, Edmonton.

10. Accommodations

The accommodations will be at the Edmonton Coast Plaza Hotel, 10155 – 105 Street. Reservations may be made by sending the CTTA a completed room list. Reservations must be made prior to February 24th, 2001.
