## INFORMATION

### 1. GENERAL INFORMATION

- (a) The Championships will be held from March 23<sup>rd</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup> 2001 at Capilano College, North Vancouver BC. An entry will only be accepted if it includes:
- participant's name, birth date, address
  - fees paid in full (payable to the CTTA)
  - signature of participant or participant's parent or guardian required.

- (b) The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of the ITTF and the CTTA.
- (c) **Note to players – Matching uniforms must be worn in team matches and all doubles events.**

### 2. ELIGIBILITY

- (a) All competitors must be Canadian citizens OR, competitors who arrived in Canada before November 6, 1989 must be Landed Immigrants with at least six months residence immediately preceding the first day of the Championships.
- (b) A competitor cannot participate in the Canadian Closed if he/she has represented another country in international competition or competed in a National Championship in another country in the year preceding the last day of the Championship.

### 3) EVENT RESTRICTIONS

- (a) Each provincial Association team member (except for the designated playing coach) MUST enter at least the Men's or Women's CHAMPIONSHIP SINGLES and one doubles event. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel or combine events due to insufficient number of entries (minimum 8 entries singles, 4 doubles).

### 4) ENTRY FEES

Championship Singles(M/W)	\$35.00
Doubles (per person)	\$17.00
Under 21(M/W)	\$20.00
Veteran I, II, III, IV (M/W)	\$20.00

Players who enter the CHAMPIONSHIP SINGLES receive a \$5.00 discount for any additional singles events entered.

### 5. FORMAT

- (a) All matches will be decided on the best two of three games, with the exception of the Championship Singles Knock-out which will be best three of five games.
- (b) In the Men's and Women's Singles the Canadian Championship format will be used – two stages of Round Robin play, then Single Knock-Out. According to their results in preliminary group play, players advance into different divisions, which will be decided in Round Robin and Single Knock-Out format.
- (c) For team matches, the Charlottetown (1999) format will be used. Team matches are best of five matches (five singles)
- (d) Doubles and Age events will be played in Round Robin and/or Single Knock-Out format.

### 6. DRAW

- (a) The draw will be held in Ottawa on Friday March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2001
- (b) The latest rating period available shall be used to determine the seeding order for all events.
- (c) The seeding of all players shall be based upon their rating points and in accordance with the Section 3, CTTA Closed Laws for National Championships.
- (d) Seeding of Doubles shall be based upon the combined rating points of both players.
- (e) Seeding for teams shall be based upon the combined total of the three highest players on the team.
- (f) Unrated players maybe given an estimated rating by the National Rating Director.

### 7. EQUIPMENT

- (a) Butterfly Europa Tables and Nets.
- (b) Stiga 3 Star White Balls

### 8. MEETINGS

- (a) The Jury Meeting will be held on Thursday, March 22<sup>nd</sup> 2001 at 7:00 PM at the Holiday Inn North Vancouver and will be chaired by the Referee. Each Provincial Association with participating athletes is entitled to one(1) vote.
- (b) The Officials Meeting will be held on Thursday, March 22<sup>nd</sup> 2001 after the Jury Meeting at the Holiday Inn North Vancouver and will be chaired by the Referee and Umpire Manager.

### 9) AWARDS

- (a) Awards will be given for semi-finalists and up in the Individual Championship Events.
- (b) Awards for winners and finalists in all other events.
