The Canadian Table Tennis Association invites all ITTF Member Associations to participate in the **2003 Canadian Junior Open • August 27-30, 2003, in Edmonton, Alberta.**

A World Junior Elite training camp and an Elite cadet training camp will be held in Edmonton from August 24 to 26, 2003.

EVENT DESCRIPTION: CANADIAN JUNIOR OPEN - WORLD JUNIOR CIRCUIT (WJC)

JUNIOR BOYS – TEAM EVENT, DOUBLES, ITTF WJC SINGLES

JUNIOR GIRLS –EVENT, DOUBLES, ITTF WJC SINGLES

JUNIORS (born in 1985 or later)

CADET BOYS – TEAM EVENT, DOUBLES AND SINGLES

CADET GIRLS – TEAM EVENT, DOUBLES AND SINGLES

CADETS (born in 1988 or later)

Singles – Stage 1 is a round-robin with a minimum of 3 players. Matches are best of 5.

Stage 2 is a knock-out system with best of 7 matches (juniors), best of 5 matches (cadets).

TEAM AND DOUBLES FORMAT WILL BE THE SAME FOR JUNIORS AND CADETS

Corbillion Cup (A-X, B-Y, doubles, A-Y, B-X)

Teams – Stage 1 teams compete in groups of 3 or 4 teams.

Matches will be best of 5 games.

Stage 2 is a knock-out system with matches being best of 5 games

Doubles - Knock-out system with best of 5 games

VENUE / HOTEL The **playing venue** will be the **Kinsmen Sports Centre** in Edmonton
The tournament **hotel** will be the **Coast Edmonton Plaza** - a four star hotel

TRAINING CAMPS WORLD JUNIOR ELITE TRAINING CAMP - August 24 – 26, 2003 (same venue as the competition). Head coach: TBA
All teams are invited to join the WJE training camp – please inform us with the entry if you plan to attend and the days you plan to attend.

NORTH AMERICAN CADET TRAINING CAMP – August 24 – 26, 2003 (same venue as the competition). Head coach: TBA
This training camp is geared toward the top North American cadet players – all other cadet players are welcome to attend the camp - please inform us with the entry if you plan to attend and the days you plan to attend.

ENTRIES An association other than the organizing association may enter up to **2 teams** per team event. The organizing association may enter up to 3 teams per team event. An association other than the organizing association can enter up to **6 boys** and **6 girls** in the cadet category and up to **6 boys** and **6 girls** in the junior category.

DRAW The draw will be conducted on 26 August at a time to be confirmed at the hotel.

EQUIPMENT Tables and Nets will be announced at least 30 days before the competition and white **Butterfly** balls will be used.



UMPIRES All matches will be officiated by qualified Umpires. The Referee will be an experienced International Referee.

TROPHIES & AWARDS Prizes for the winner, runner-up and semi-finalists in all events.

HOSPITALITY A hospitality package including hotel (****), breakfast buffet and transportation from and to Edmonton International Airport and between the hotel and the playing venue is offered:

Room for double, triple and quadruple occupancy are equipped with two **double** beds. All rooms have the standard amenities – TV, en-suite bathroom and shower, telephone, etc.

Athletes, coaches and officials are responsible for their lunches and dinners. A number of restaurants are within walking distance with meals at reasonable prices (U\$ 5 – U\$ 10). A map with nearby restaurants will be provided.

An additional three will be selected from the ITTF U18 World Ranking, with proof of participation in at least one ITTF World Junior Circuit event during the year.

One wild card will be reserved for the host association making a total of ten boys and ten girls for the finals.
